PRELIMINARY RECITALS

Pursuant to petition filed December 3, 2015, under Wis. Admin. Code §HA 3.03, and 7 C.F.R. § 273.16, to review a decision by Milwaukee Enrollment Services to disqualify Marquis Roberts from receiving FoodShare benefits (FS) for a period of one year, a hearing was held on March 29, 2016. Respondent did not appear. The Division of Hearings and Appeals issued a Decision on April 13, 2016 that sustained the imposition of a 1 year FoodShare intentional program violation disqualification. Respondent then submitted a written request for a rehearing. That request was granted. A new hearing was scheduled for September 7, 2016. Respondent did not appear on September 7, 2016 and no new hearing was held as the agency evidence was the same as presented in the original hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

That the original Decision issued on April 13, 2016 that sustained the imposition of a one year disqualification of receipt of FoodShare because of an intentional program violation is unchanged.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED

That the Petitioner’s determination is sustained, and that the Petitioner may make a finding that the Respondent committed a first IPV of the FoodShare program and disqualify the Respondent from the program for one year, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this Decision if it has not done so already following the original Decision in this matter.

APPEAL TO COURT

You may also appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals must be filed with the Court **and** served either personally or by certified mail on the Secretary of the Department of Health Services, 1 West Wilson Street, Room 651, Madison, WI 53703, **and** on those identified in this decision as “PARTIES IN INTEREST” **no more than 30 days after the date of this decision** or 30 days after a denial of a timely rehearing request (if you request one).
