The Office of The Inspector General (OIG) requested a hearing under 7 C.F.R. §273.16 requesting that a FoodShare first Intentional Program Violation determination be entered against the above-named respondent, and that a 12 month disqualification penalty be imposed for trafficking her FoodShare benefits with T and J Grocery Store.

Prior to the administrative law judge holding a hearing, the respondent signed a waiver on August 13, 2012 which was received at DHA on August 19, 2013. Therefore, the agency may impose the requested sanction.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is **ORDERED**

That the respondent, ██████████ ██████████, is hereby ineligible to participate in the FoodShare program for a period of 12 months, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this decision.


APPEAL TO COURT

You may also appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the Wisconsin county in which the violation occurred. Appeals to Circuit Court must be filed no more than 30 days after the date of this hearing decision (or 30 days after a denial of a rehearing, if you ask for one).

For purposes of appeal to Circuit court, the Respondent in this matter is the Department of Health Services. Appeals must be served on the Secretary of that Department, either personally or by certified mail. The address of the Department is 1 West Wilson Street, Madison, Wisconsin, 53703. The process for appeals to the Circuit Court is contained in Wis. Stat. § 227.53.
