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The Public Assistance Collection Unit (PACU) requested a hearing under 7 C.F.R. §273.16 requesting that a FoodShare Intentional Program Violation determination be entered against the above-named respondent, and that a 1-year disqualification penalty be imposed for a first violation of FoodShare rules.

Prior to the administrative law judge holding a hearing, the respondent signed a waiver. Therefore, the agency may impose the requested sanction.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is **ORDERED**

That the respondent, ██████████ ██████████, is hereby ineligible to participate in the FoodShare program for a period of one year, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this decision.

**APPEAL TO COURT**


You may appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals to Circuit Court must be filed no more than 30 days after the date of this hearing decision.

For purposes of appeal to Circuit court, the Respondent in this matter is the Department of Health Services. Appeals must be served on the Secretary of that Department, either personally or by certified mail. The address of the Department is 1 West Wilson Street, Madison, Wisconsin, 53703. The process for appeals to the Circuit Court is contained in Wis. Stat. § 227.53.
