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The Office of the Inspector General requested a hearing under 7 C.F.R. §273.16 requesting that a FoodShare Intentional Program Violation determination be entered against ██████████ ██████████ and that a one year disqualification penalty be imposed for trafficking FS.

Prior to the administrative law judge holding a hearing, the respondent signed a waiver. Therefore, the agency may impose the requested sanction.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** it is **ORDERED**

That the respondent, ██████████ ██████████, is hereby ineligible to participate in the FoodShare program for a period of one year, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this decision.

**APPEAL TO COURT**

You may appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals must be served and filed with the appropriate court no more than 30 days after the date of this hearing decision (or 30 days after a denial of rehearing, if you ask for one).
