The above-named petitioner requested a hearing under Chapter HA 3, Wis. Admin. Code, in regard to the Adoption Assistance Program. Prior to a hearing, this office was advised that the matter had been settled by stipulation dated January 29, 2014 and received by the Division of Hearings and Appeals on February 7, 2014.

Therefore, this office will dismiss the petition for review.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That the matter is hereby remanded to the Department of Children and Families with instructions to proceed to provide to the petitioners the Adoption Assistance benefits agreed to in the parties' Stipulation.

CIRCUIT COURT APPEAL

You may also appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals must be filed no more than 30 days after the date of this hearing decision.

For purposes of appeal to Circuit Court, the respondent is the Department of Children and Families. Appeals must be served on the Office of the Secretary of that Department, either personally or by certified mail. The address of the Department is: 201 East Washington Avenue, Second Floor, Madison, WI 53703. The process for appeals to the Circuit Court is in Wisconsin Statutes §§ 227.52 and 227.53.
