The Dane County Department of Human Services ["County"] requested a Hearing under 7 C.F.R. §273.16 requesting that a FoodShare ["FS"] Intentional Program Violation ["IPV"] determination be entered against ██████████ ██████████ and that a one year disqualification penalty be imposed for reporting no longer operating a business when, in fact, the business continued in operation and, also, reporting rent expense for housing when there was no rent expense paid (stayed with mother).

Prior to the Administrative Law Judge ["ALJ"] holding a Hearing, Respondent signed a waiver. Therefore, the agency may impose the requested sanction.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is **ORDERED**

That Respondent, ██████████ ██████████, is hereby ineligible to participate in the FS program for a period of one year, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this decision.

APPEAL TO COURT

You may also appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals must be filed with the Court **and** served either personally or by certified mail on the Secretary of the Department of Health Services, 1 West Wilson Street, Room 651, Madison, WI 53703, **and** on those identified in this decision as "PARTIES IN INTEREST" **no more than 30 days after the date of this decision** or 30 days after a denial of a timely rehearing request (if you request one).

The process for Circuit Court Appeals may be found at Wis. Stat. §§ 227.52 and 227.53. A copy of the statutes may be found online or at your local library or courthouse.
