The Langlade County Department of Social Services requested a hearing under 7 C.F.R. §273.16 requesting that a FoodShare Intentional Program Violation determination be entered against [REDACTED] and that a one year disqualification penalty be imposed based upon its allegation that the respondent provided false information regarding her FoodShare household.

Prior to the administrative law judge holding a hearing, the respondent signed a Waiver of Administrative Disqualification Hearing. She indicated the following when she signed the Waiver: "I do not admit the facts as presented are correct. However, I have chosen to sign this waiver and understand that a disqualification penalty will result." Based upon the record, I conclude that the petitioner may impose the requested sanction.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That the respondent, [REDACTED], is hereby ineligible to participate in the FoodShare program for a period of one year, effective the first month following the date of receipt of this decision.

APPEAL TO COURT

You may appeal this decision to Circuit Court in the county where you live. Appeals must be filed with the Court **and** served either personally or by certified mail on the Secretary of the Department of Health Services, 1 West Wilson Street, Room 651, Madison, WI 53703, **and** on those identified in this decision as "PARTIES IN INTEREST" **no more than 30 days after the date of this decision** or 30 days after a denial of a timely rehearing request (if you request one).

The process for Circuit Court Appeals may be found at Wis. Stat. §§ 227.52 and 227.53. A copy of the statutes may be found online or at your local library or courthouse.
