## **Public Records Board Comments**

Any correspondence generated by individuals or groups which are part of state government functions are public documents. The people of Wisconsin paid for them and have a right to know what is in any of these documents or correspondence. No person or group has any right to withhold or redact this information from the public, which owns them in their entirety. The people who generate this correspondence work for Wisconsin residents and have no legal right to withhold or hide any of this information. Anyone who withholds information generated in the course of their duties as employees of the state of Wisconsin are very likely to find themselves out of a job after this election year. Do not allow public access to the workings of our state government to be hidden or otherwise withheld from the people of Wisconsin. We have a right to know what is being done by people who are supposedly representing our best interests.
