Subject: Transitory Records

I am very concerned about the policy revision in which the Board changed the definition of "transitory records". No communications via telephone, email, text, Facebook or other electronic communications by public employees about public business should be considered "transitory". When government employees are spending taxpayers' dollars to conduct public business electronically, citizens have an interest in those communications and a right to see them. As the Public Records Board, you have a responsibility to keep our records **open** for the public. It is your job to preserve all records.

I am also very concerned that the policy revision made in August was done without no public notice or reporting. I do not want our government officials to hide information behind this kind of policy and would have let you know my feelings if asked prior to your policy change. **Keep public records PUBLIC!**

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
